

Bursa Uludağ University has been contributing to the scientific development of Turkey by means of modern educational methods since 1975. We are bringing Uludağ University to top step by step in coordination with all our stakeholders and our aim is to be ranked among the top ten Turkish universities.

General Information

Bursa Uludag University is a state University established in 1975. It has been successfully continuing its educational services ever since with its 15 faculties, 2 school, 15 vocational schools, 1 conservatory, 4 institutes, 27 applied research centers, 1 research center and 4 departments under rectorate.

The Rectorate, the institutes, Vocational School of Health Services, Technical Sciences Vocational School and most of the faculties are located on central campus in Görükle with an area of 16 million m2 and 20 km away from the city center. Faculty of Theology in Fethiye Campus, School of Foreign Languages and Vocational School of Social Sciences are in Ali Osman Sönmez campus. Faculty of Law, Gemlik Asım Kocabiyik Vocational School are on Gemlik Sunğipek-Asım Kocabiyik campus in Gemlik; Faculty of Fine Arts is in Mudanya. The schools in Mustafakemalpaşa, Karacabey, İnegöl, İznik, Yenişehir İbrahim Orhan, Orhangazi, Orhaneli, Keles, Harmancık and Büyükşehirhan have been continuing their education where they are named after the districts they were founded.

In the academic year 2019-2020, around 75.586 students are studying at Uludağ University. Approximately of these; 46.043 are undergraduate, 20.994 are associate degree, 77 are conservatory, 608 are residency, 5.728 are master, and 2.136 are doctorate students. Around 7.000 of these are international students.

In the academic year 2019-2020, Bursa Uludağ University has a total has more than 2.500 teaching staff and more than 4.100 administrative staff.

With its staff of more than 2500 academicians and experienced administrators, It is one of the biggest universities in Turkey.

As an institution that has embraced contemporary values It has adopted social change, scientific approach, raising qualified staff, academic freedom, support for students, life long learning and serving society as principles.

In our university whose goal is to create internationally equivalent programmes, the contents of our undergraduate and graduate programmes have been brought into conformity with other national and international programmes. In all our programmes a credit based system is used to comply with the European Credit Transfer System.

By means of the Erasmus Student Exchange Programme, students are sent to reputable universities in Europe thereby contributing to their scientific, social and cultural development.

In order to prepare our students for the European Union, students are issued a Diploma Supplement (a document in English that makes all programmes internationally valid and is recognized by the EU) appended to their Diplomas.

Double Major and Minor opportunities are offered to successful undergraduate students.

With regard to the level of progress it has made, our university has been designated as "excellent" in terms of its change capacity among the European universities that have been assessed so far by the European Universities Association assessment team.

As far as education and research reforms are concerned, our university has been accepted as a successful model for all the namely-established universities in Europe as part of the "Quality Culture Project" conducted by the European Universities Association.

It is accredited by national and international accreditation bodies and has educational and application areas and departments that provide education at world standards.

Applied training and education opportunities are offered in Turkey's most important industrial and private sector organizations.

Uludağ university has been chosen as one of the 16 research universities by the Higher Education Council (YÖK)

Our university is among the top 20 defined by Higher Education Council as Internationalization Universities.

With our portal prepared for our international students, we support our students to get in touch with the leading industrial and private sector organizations of Bursa.

Life on campus

Estimated living expenses for students are 200 to 250 Euros per month including the cost of accommodation, food - drink and transportation.

All incoming students can find a suitable accommodation on Görükle Campus. The monthly cost of a room for an incoming student is about 80 €.

Those students who wish to stay in private hostels, guest houses or rented homes may find accommodation at suitable prices in the city centre, suburbs and in Görükle.

Dining halls in the campus offer meals controlled by dieticians at affordable prices. Also in and around campus, canteens and cafes, as well as fast food restaurants and pastry shops, are available.

Educational activities in various sports are organized by the teaching staff of the Physical Education and Sports Department for our students to make productive use of their free time, do sports for a healthy and happy life, get to know each other and develop physically and mentally. The students who participate in sports activities during the academic year get the chance to represent our university in local and inter-university competitions and experience the feeling of becoming successful sportsmen/sportswomen and champions.

Students can get to and around the city by bus and metro with a discount fare using their student transportation cards (BuKart).
